



Shire of Derby / West Kimberley QUICK GRANTS

The purpose of the Shire of Derby / West Kimberley Quick Grants is to provide easy access to funds which help organisations to offer programs, services and events throughout the Shire of Derby / West Kimberley.

What are Quick Grants used for?

Quick Grants are typically used to help any not for profit community organisation meet their stated objectives. In the past Quick Grants have been provided to everyone from the local footy team and school dance group to an environmental clean up effort.

Some examples of how Quick Grants have been used are included below:

- Training – to conduct coaching clinics and training for officials
- Sport Equipment – to buy equipment (other than personal gear)
- Establishment – to help new organisations get off the ground
- Shows, Exhibitions, Festivals and Sporting Events – costs incurred
- Equipment - used in cultural or other activities including consumables
- Professional Development - to provide learning opportunities for others such as volunteers and committee members
- Waive Fees – to waive the normal fees associated with hire of a Council venue or use of the large marquee
- Access Council resources – such as use of plant or personnel

How much can I apply for?

You can apply for up to \$500 in one application. Quick Grants don't require any matching contributions although organisations which show how they are also contributing are highly valued.

When can I apply for a Quick Grant?

Quick Grants can be applied for at any time throughout the year. Make sure you submit your application form **at least four weeks** before you require the funding.

You may apply only once in each financial year.

How do I apply?

Complete the form provided and return it to the Shire **at least four weeks** prior to your event.
