DERBY AIRPORT REDEVELOPMENT

The Shire of Derby/West Kimberley has recently finalised its funding agreement with the Department of Infrastructure and Regional Development for its \$5 million contribution to the redevelopment of Derby Airport. The project will see the development of a new airport terminal building, new tourism lounge, upgrades to the carpark, new precinct wide fire-fighting system, backup power generator and upgrade to the airside tarmac and lighting.

The redevelopment of the airport will provide Derby with a Category 3 airport which will facilitate commercial transport aircraft and is hoped will see a return of a Regular Passenger service to Derby by having lower running costs than Curtin for the jet services. The development also allows additional land leases to be considered in the future.

At the 23 February 2017 Ordinary Council meeting the Shire approved the delivery model which links to employment and training opportunities to local CDP participants throughout the delivery of the project and is part of the grant requirements. The Shire has engaged with the Derby Chamber of Commerce help communicate the development stages, project objectives, and specific procurement requirements to provide opportunities to local businesses to the project where possible.

The project is currently in the approvals process with work on site expected to commence in late April with an anticipated construction program of 11 months.
