

How to Set a Cat Trap

1. Prepare the trap

Line the bottom of the trap with newspaper to prevent the cat from seeing the trigger plate and for easier cleanup.

2. Bait the trap

Place a strong smelling bait, such as tuna in oil, sardines, or mackerel, at the very back of the trap, beyond the trigger plate.

3. Set the door

Lift the trap door up and lift the trigger assembly. Pull the door's trigger bar back under the hook to hold it in the open position.

4. Cover the trap

Once set, cover the entire trap with a blanket or sheet to help the cat feel safer and less panicked when the door closes.

5. Monitor the cage frequently

Monitor the cage frequently everyday.

6. Call the Ranger to collect the cat

Call the ranger on 9191 0999 to arrange with Ranger to collect cat.

*Please do not set the trap on Fridays, Saturdays and days leading up to a Public Holiday. The Ranger is unavailable to collect on these days.
