

Good News Stories: Voyd Green -Remote Area Plumbing

My name is Voyd Green and I'm the director of Remote Area Plumbing. I was born and raised in Fitzroy and been here ever since. Fitzroy to me is home. It's where it all started and what I am doing now is my way of giving back to all that I have received in my time.

I have been a plumber since 2006 where I started helping out my brother on weekends until I got offered an apprenticeship. After three years working I transferred to the East Kimberley, completed my trade and did FIFO work before realising I could do the work on my own and studied hard to start up my plumbing business.

In the beginning of the floods we started helping with the evacuations and general tidy up of houses and debris. We then started installing the workers camps and now just trying to get people back into their homes through plumbing and installation. We have been so busy since the floods that we have not stopped and we now have 7 employees that consist of plumbers and support workers.

This year when the floods came it was a different kind of season. Usually we go out fishing and hunting while the rain comes as its the best time of the year, but not this year. All I could think about was what I could to help out as I did have a boat and tried my best to transport people and animals back and forth during that time. We also helped out with businesses like IGA and Ghostgum, doing whatever was needed to help out.

I helped out the community as best I could because this is what community is all about, even though I wasn't directly affected by the floods I can help those less fortunate than I am.

At the moment, day-to-day life is scheduling works, making sure tools and materials are ready for whatever job arises and helping out with whatever jobs are being done during the day.

We would love to get our profile out there that there is business in Fitzroy and we would love to help out wherever we can. There is also lots of opportunity for more people to start up businesses here and get involved in the community as much as possible.

DISASTER RECOVERY ASSISTANCE PACKAGES

Seven recovery packages were announced on 7 July to support individuals and communities affected by the Kimberley Floods.

Jointly funded through the Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements, these packages provide financial support for ongoing recovery across the Kimberley. The latest round of assistance includes funding for the following programs:

- Repair and Rebuild of Government Housing and Damaged Community Access Roads
- Homeowners Recovery and Resilience Grants
- Primary Producer Recovery Grants
- Small Business Recovery Grants
- Medium Business Recovery Grants
- Stage Two Temporary Residential Accommodation
- Temporary Workers Accommodation
