
Fitzroy Crossing Community Meeting

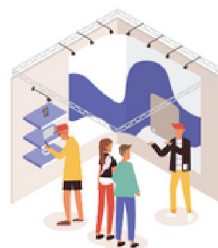

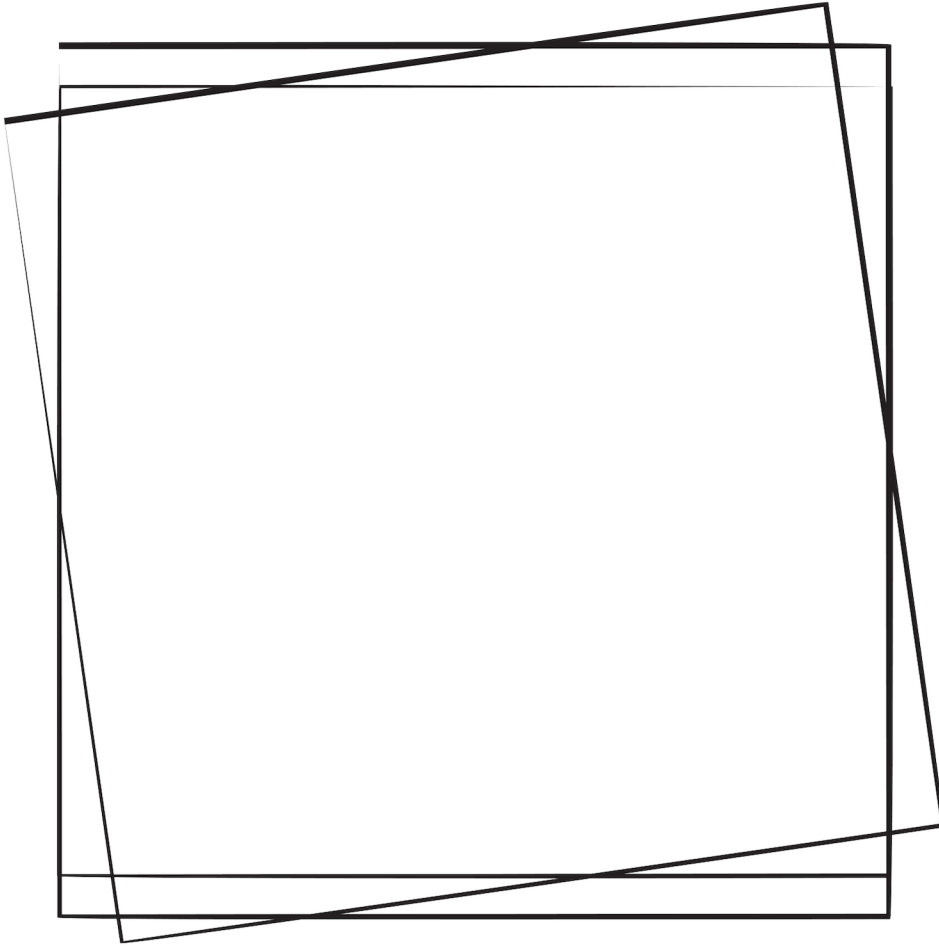
