This week, our community came together to host three impactful open days - the Flood Hub grants open day, Aboriginal Justice Open day and Jobs Expo - each contributing to the community's development.

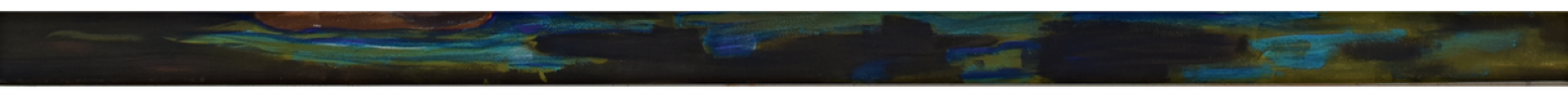
