FIRE SAFETY & REQUIREMENTS

The Shire of Derby/West Kimberley would like to remind people to remain fire safe and to take measures to prevent the spread of fires.

Property owners and occupiers must comply with the Shire of Derby/West Kimberley Fire Break & Hazard Reduction Notice by 30 June 2023:

Unauthorised, deliberately lit fires can cause significant damage to people, property, businesses and the environment.
