CLARENDON STREET UPGRADE

By date of this publication, most of the new concrete footpaths will have been completed along both sides of Clarendon Street and the feature paving inserts should be nearing completion. Locations for the future installation of trees and new bin enclosures have also been finalized.

The next stage of works will focus on the installation of the pedestrian crossover points and completion of the feature paving and vehicle crossovers.

The proprietor of the Shell Service Station recently requested the provision of an opening in the new centre median isle that would allow vehicles to exit the property and make a right hand turn and travel east along Clarendon Street. An initial assessment of this request was undertaken and a number of options were put before Council.

On advice received, the Council have determined to maintain the current configuration and not undertake any further modifications to the centre median until such time that further engineering and design investigations

have been completed with a report to be provided back to Council by end February 2017.

As an interim measure and to assist with traffic flow from the property, modifications have been made to the kerb line to assist with over length vehicles exiting the property and making a left hand turn out toward the Clarendon/Hardman Street roundabout. A full copy of the report considered by the Council is detailed in the Council Minutes and is available of the Shire website.

We continue to seek to minimise the impact on people wanting to access business's and shops which has seen the most disruptive of works undertaken afterhours and on weekends and we thank our business owners and community members for their patience and support whilst these works are being undertaken

NEW PLAYGROUND FOR FITZROY CROSSING

Council has recently received funding of for the construction of an all abilities shaded playground, location to be confirmed. The equipment will be focused on 5 - 12 year olds and is expected to be installed in early 2017.
