FIREBREAK NOTICES

All land owners within the Shire have been served a notice regarding fire breaks and fire control measures required by 1 July 2017.

The owner or occupier of land to whom a notice has been given who fails or neglects in any respect duly to comply with the requisitions of the notice is guilty of an offence.

Failure or to neglect to do so may result in a penalty of \$250.00 and the Shire may engage contractors to complete works, and invoice the owner or occupier of land.

DERBY TOWNSITE COASTAL HAZARD RISK MANAGEMENT AND ADAPTATION PLAN

As required under the State Planning Policy Framework, the Shire has now prepared a Draft Coastal Hazard Risk Management and Adaption Plan (CHRMAP). The CHRMAP has been developed having regard to the consultation received from the community post the workshops held in September 2016 to evaluate the identified coastal hazards and develop suitable risk management and adoption measures. The CHRMAP process involves stakeholder and community engagement to:

Consider coastal hazards and evaluate their likelihood and the consequence for specific assets;

Identify realistic and effective management and adaptation responses to those risks; and

Prioritise potential management and adaptation responses.

The Draft CHRMAP document is now available for inspection and comments on the document may be submitted to the Shire in writing, addressed to the Chief Executive Officer on or before the <u>Thursday 29th June 2017.</u>

MOSQUITO MANAGEMENT



Residents of Derby and surrounding communities are reminded that the activity of disease carrying mosquitos could increase with the recent wet season activity.

In WA, mosquitos can transmit Ross River, Barmah Forest, Murray Valley Encephalitis (MVE) and Kunjin (KUN) viruses. There are no cures or vaccines for any of these diseases.
