ANIMAL REGISTRATION

Cat and dog registrations are coming up on the 1st November so it is time to consider whether you have any that are required to be registered.

Dogs over the age of three months are required to be registered and all new dogs registered for the first time or are transferred to a new owner, need to be microchipped.

You will be required to provide proof that your dog has been microchipped by providing the microchip number.

Cat registrations are also are due on the 1st November. All cats that have reached six months of age are required to be sterilized microchipped and registered.
