RESIDENTIAL VERGE COLLECTION

As a reminder, the next residential verge collection will commence at 6:00am on Monday the 26th November.

Waste MUST be separated into 3 Separate piles.

We will only remove:

- Garden (Green) waste
- Whitegoods and Metals
- Everything else (No Household Consumable Waste)

We will not remove:

- Bricks, rubble, concrete, sand or building waste.
- Liquids of any kind, such as paint and oils.
- Gas bottles of any size.
- Tyres or Batteries
- Asbestos cement products.



Waste will not be collected if placed within 1.5m of any structures such as:

- Fences
- kerbs
- Trees, Water
- Meters/Mains
- Power Poles
- Telstra Markers etc.
