#### Fitzroy Crossing Airport Fencing Renewed

The Shire has recently undertaken works to fully enclose the Fitzroy Crossing Airport Facility.

Federal and State Governments have funded 3kms of fencing to improve the safety of medical and aviation services. It is intended to help prevent animal strikes, particularly at night. This work was completed by local builder - Archer Builders.

The Shire asset is a key resource in the provision of health across the Fitzroy Valley and supports services such as the Royal Flying Doctor Service, visiting specialists and patient transfers.
