DERBY AIRPORT - UPDATE

Derby Airport continues its evolution towards becoming a modern port with the capacity to service a broad range of industries.

The main terminal construction is complete with the fit out of functional equipment such as security screening and furniture soon underway.

Another major step is demolition of the old terminal and placement of the buildings to undergo their transformation into the new Tourism Air Lounge.

The apron and lighting work remains in abeyance until the water table drops to enable earthworks. With the water table just 300mm below the surface, any holes or trenches quickly backfill with water creating an unworkable bog.

The anticipated time for completion at this stage is mid-July.

SHEFFIELD RESOURCES

You may have heard last week that Sheffield Resources have signed a binding Port Access Agreement at the Wharf with the Shire that spans a minimum of twenty years.

This is an important element as they now have security over the export pathway to international markets.

Shire President Geoff Haerewa and CEO Stephen Gash were recently in Perth to sign the documents that have now been fully executed by all parties

Geoff has welcomed this significant step saying "It has been a long and complex process working with the Department of Transport and Sheffield Resources, navigating through a myriad of legislative requirements.

The benefits I see for Derby and the West Kimberley region will be opportunities for local businesses that will generate employment which has always been our focus in discussions with proponents looking to invest in our Shire."

FIRE BREAKS - REMINDER

Please note that if you have been previously been advised by the Shire that your property is required to have a firebreak, these need to be addressed prior to 30 June.

The type of firebreak is dependent on the nature of your property or particular site, including:

- Rural Lands
- Pastoral Lands
- Townsite Lands
- Rubbish Sites
- Fuel Dumps and Depots

DERBY PORT MAINTENANCE UPDATE

Completion of the deck works on the southern abutment has been reached allowing the passage of vehicles, including triple road trains, full access and eliminating the need to reverse trailers via the northern abutment.
