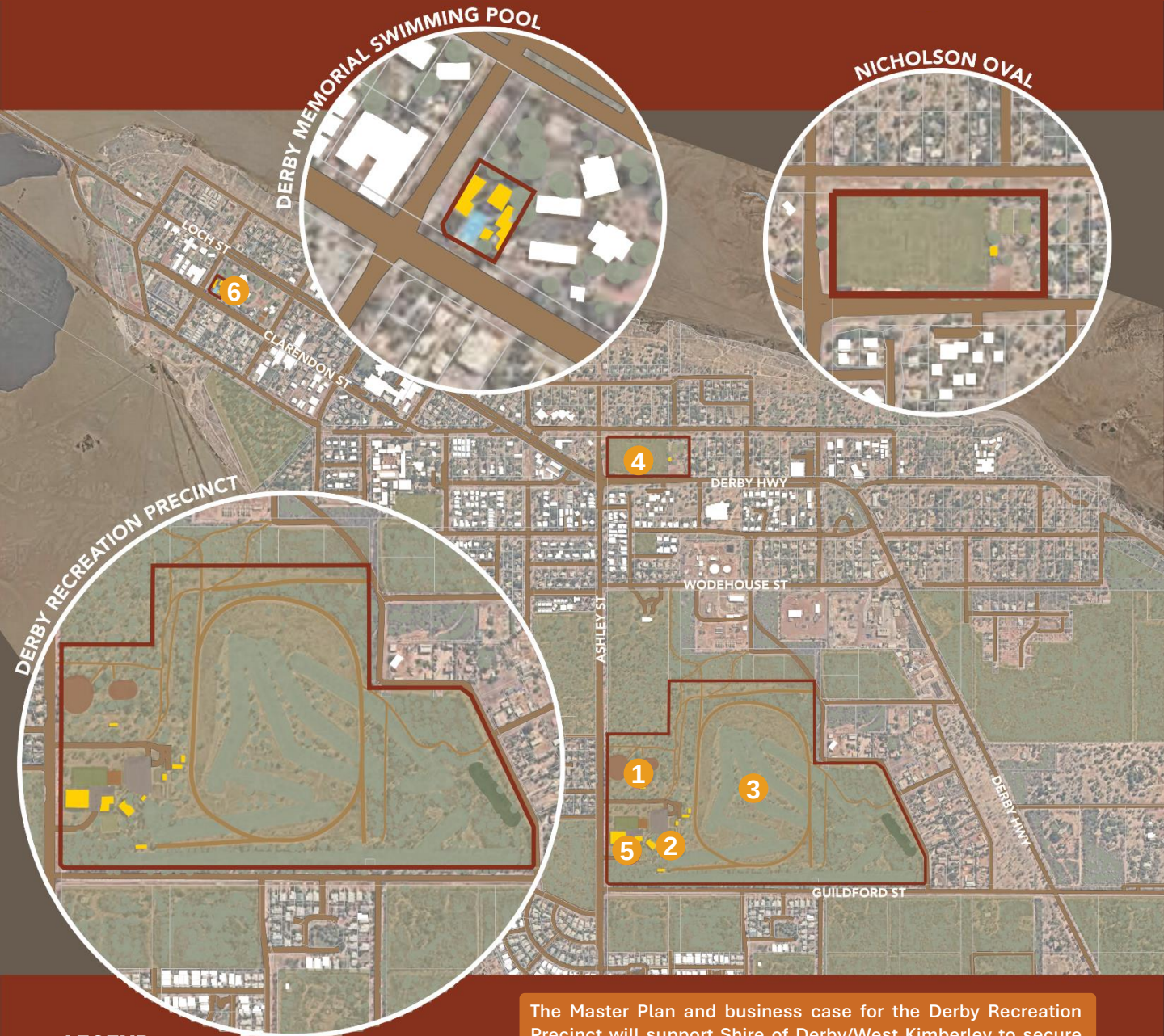

Develop a shared, inclusive long term vision for the Derby Recreation Precinct that reflects community aspirations and supports recreation, sport, culture, wellbeing and shared community outcomes.

Undertake culturally secure engagement and establish Cultural Protocols with Aboriginal people and Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisations to foster community ownership of the Master Plan.

Assess existing facilities, assets, governance arrangements and access barriers to inform future planning and funding opportunities.

Understand the needs and priorities of residents, user groups, organisations and stakeholders, balancing current and emerging issues.

Explore opportunities for renewal, share infrastructure, multi-use facilities, community gathering spaces and economic development through events and sports tourism.

Embed an ongoing, accessible and inclusive engagement process that continually informs and refines the Master Plan.

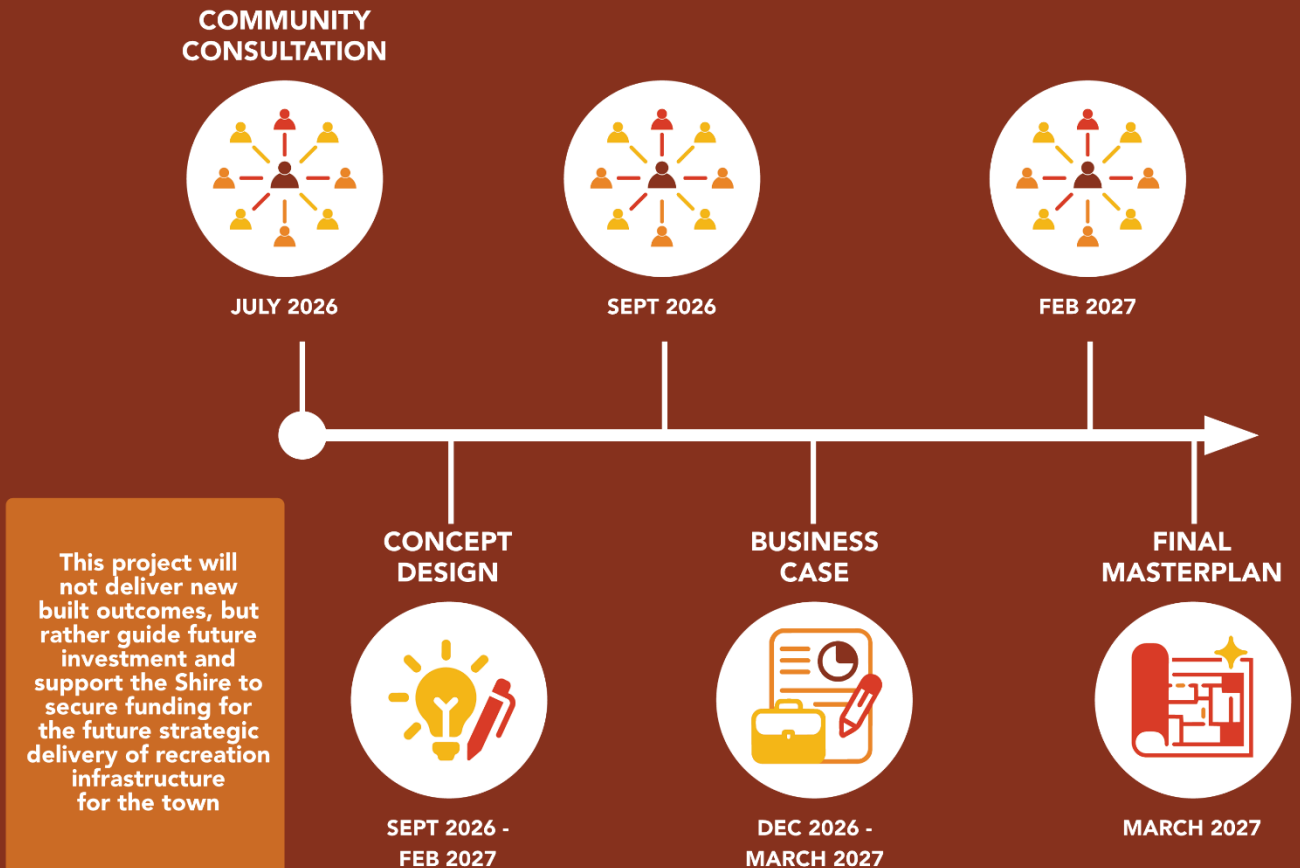
