



AF21 – FIRE CONTROL OFFICERS AUTHORITIES

OBJECTIVE

To set guidelines as to the value of financial commitment a Fire Control Officer, without prior approval from the CEO or President, may make on behalf of the Shire toward the control of bush fires.

POLICY

The Chief Executive Officer, Chief Bushfire Control Officer and Deputy Chief Bushfire Control Officer are authorised to hire or by whatever means, procure the use of equipment or machinery for the use of fire control in the Shire of Derby/West Kimberley.

Fire Control Officers, other than the Chief Bushfire Control Officer or Deputy Chief Bushfire Control Officer, are limited to authorising the use of equipment or machinery to a value not exceeding \$500.00 per fire incident. All expenditure over this amount must be approved by either the Chief Executive Officer, Chief Bushfire Control Officer or Deputy Chief Bushfire Control Officer.
